Priority Needs

T6 NuStep Exercise Equipment. Provides veterans with a safe, low-impact way to stay active, maintain independence, and improve mobility. Features include a dual-touchscreen console with scenic exercise views, a 22-inch-wide seat supporting up to 600 pounds, low step-through access, 15 resistance levels, smooth stepping motion, and locking handles for added safety and comfort.

Concert Series. Purpose: Seeking funds to provide a 3-month summer concert program at the Iowa Veterans Home to enhance the quality of life for our veterans. Offering concerts on campus allows a larger number of veterans to participate and enjoy live music, while alleviating the need for transporting a small group of veterans to an off-site concert event.

General Memorial Fund. Purpose: This fund supports a variety of campus wide projects. Purchases include: furniture for sitting areas, unit décor, outdoor furniture, medical equipment, exercise equipment, interactive therapy games to promote mental, physical and social stimulation, and adaptive equipment.

Recreation Fund. Purpose: This fund is used to purchase resident admission costs to all recreational outings such as to sporting events, movies, the zoo, and museums. It also provides special meals, prizes for bingo, and our Wednesday popcorn program. This fund also supports our bowling program, garden boxes, and inviting music and other entertainers to perform for residents here at the Iowa Veterans Home.

Christmas Fund. Purpose: Allows IVH to purchase Christmas gifts for each resident from contributions received in this Christmas Fund. A list of gift choices is given to each resident for them to create their Christmas Wish List. Gifts are presented to residents at their holiday parties.

Library Support. Purpose: The IVH Library is a wonderful place for our residents to spend time reading, using the computers or checking out materials. We strive to have materials available that are interesting and current. Monetary donation designated for the library will be used to purchase new DVDs, Blu-rays or large print books for everyone to enjoy.
